99S PILOT STORY |

TINA GOUIN | USDA INSPECTOR

HOMETOWN - Born and raised in College Park, Maryland, I spent my Sundays bike riding with my parents and sister to the College Park airport to watch the planes, and then we would bike to the Ercoupe factory runway just south to watch the model planes fly. I found a slightly damaged propeller and had my dad mount it to the front wire basket of my bicycle so I could fly. My dad was a college professor and we would take him to a grass farm strip sometimes and watch him fly off to meetings in his friends 172. The runway wasn't flat and his friend the pilot would take off on the third rise. Weekends were sometimes spent going to local airshows in Manassas VA to watch the stunt planes and wing walkers. In 1993 I moved to Deale, MD and in 2013 going through a rough and failing marriage I finally took flying lessons, starting at NAFC out of KANP but finishing at W00 Freeway Airport. A few lessons we landed on MD22 my friends grass Strip in Deale. My CFI said I landed like a pro on grass... pilot friends in Canada who taught me that trick.

HOBBIES - besides flying I craft stained glass using the copper foil method and have done several aviation themed panels for friends. I also play golf though I am distracted a bit because our golf course Fairwinds lies at the end of 10L and to the side of 10R of KFPR.. so oh shiny moments interrupt my swing some days. LOL. I also have a horse, Rio, 24 yrs young pasture potato that I ride when its not too hot around the farm I board him at. My current partner also got me involved in shooting sporting clays... Think an almost golf version of clay shooting with different stations to shoot from. I have 2 rescue dogs, 1 cat and 2 parrots. I used to foster rescue dogs when I had my house and then farm in Maryland, 135 dogs total.

CURRENT ROLE/OR RATINGS- VFR was gained in November of 2015. I am current.

AVIATION GOALS - My goal this year (or next) is to fly my bird to Canada and land at my friend's farm field for their BBQ. I've attended by car for 10 yrs.

BEST FLYING EXPERIENCE - I have been taken up by several stunt pilots for full bore show level stunt rides in Canada, talk about the funnest rollercoaster ride ever! My friend Bruce has also been teaching me wing overs in his Citabria. Does landing at Sun N Fun on the green dot count? What a blast!

CURRENT AIRCRAFT N7178T Cessna 172A - "Blue Bird" was purchased in March of 2021 and then proceeded to be in an annual for 9 months.. that is was "airworthy" was severely looked into when the carb heat failed and both mufflers could be jiggled in place due to rusted out studs.

I am currently a federal agriculture inspection agent with USDA and fly commercial all over the country inspecting field trials. I hope to fly my own plane to a few though renting a car for a few hours in most places is not possible and use of a courtesy car for federal duty is not allowed. Boo.
